

As a long-term supporter, the National Union of Journalists wishes the congratulate you on the successful outcome to the Shot at Dawn Campaign (Ireland) that you organised to win pardons for the Irish-born troops executed by the British Army for battlefield offences in the First World War.

We, as a union, have marched alongside you at the Remembrance Day parades at the Cenotaph in London since 2000 and it was our honour to be asked to lay the wreathe in remembrance of the Irish victims of the British Army Act at the 2006 ceremony.
